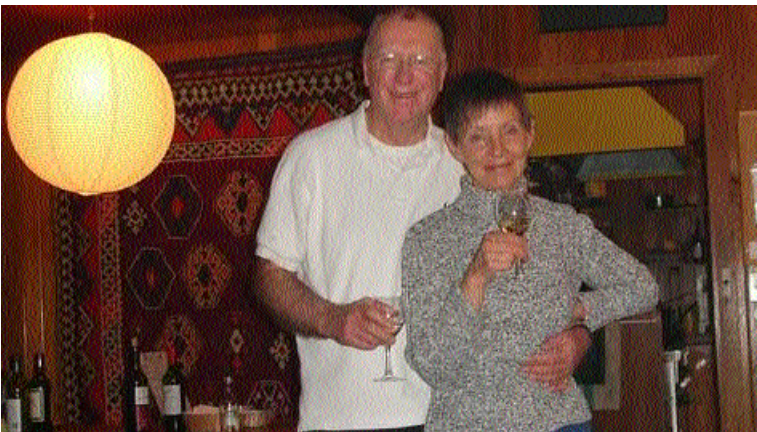

Board Report September, 2005

1. Lodge management

The current lodge management structure was reviewed and a number of issues had surfaced during 2004 and again in 2005. Some of these issues were pronounced during the 2005 season due to a decreased level of bookings.

Following general discussions the Board decided to revert back to the previous management structure for next year, where the in-lodge manager's would report directly to the Board.

Terry tabled and reviewed a management proposal from Belinda and Michael which the Board accepted.

2. Financial reports

Terry reported that Gae is now a signatory to cheques. Terry added that he and Gae now have access to internet banking.

3. Review of Booking Procedures

Bookings including forwarding of phone/fax numbers will be handed over to the managers of the lodge when they take up residency.

Repairs and Maintenance

4.1 Jon reported that the end of season Working Bee would go ahead in November.

4.2 The code lock on the front door will be changed for summer.

4.3 A quote and repair of the TV antenna will be organised.

4.4 The carpet in the lounge/dining room and adjoining hall will be replaced. Surrounding floor tiles will also be installed around the fire place.

4.5 We are progressing the project of renovating the bathrooms.

Nathalie Verunica and Anthony Fagan have volunteered their experienced services to assist in the upkeep of the web site. The board thanks them both and also Michael Soden who has helped us out in the interim.

LOCKERS

We now have 20 new boot lockers as well as our existing 55 Ski lockers.

From January 1, all lockers will be available for lease on a yearly basis of \$25 per locker, or \$40 for a combined-boot and a ski locker.

Due to the limited number of lockers available, initial orders will be taken for one ski locker and one boot locker per member. To avoid disappointment, please get your money into Doug ASAP. From March 1 excess lockers will be available for lease.

Please note, if you have items in lockers which you have not leased from January 1 these items will be removed and stored in the entry until the start of the season, at which time they will be disposed of.

Due to short availability of lockers, if not used in two winter seasons, they will need to be relinquished to skiing members
